Project Name	Timberline Residence
What was your vision for the space and what were your design goals?	Minimalist modern design with subdued interiors comprised of white walls, concrete and steel to provide a backdrop to the stunning view of the Bridger Mountain Range and Gallatin Valley sunsets. The ability to open up the large open public space to the outside in warm weather while providing a fully open view during inclement weather.
